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This week in 4th grade:

Homework—

Beginning next week, homework will look different for both reading and math. Students should continue to read 20 minutes each night, but they will be receiving comprehension passages and math review sheets in place of the reading activities and Engage NY work they have previously been using.

Reading—

We are continuing our unit on reading technical, scientific, and historical texts. Next week we will begin reviewing for the EOGs, beginning with a review of elements in literature.

Writing—

This week we will continue to practice referencing evidence from the texts in our answers to various passages.

Social Studies—

We are continuing our study on the American Revolution including important battles in the country and North Carolina's role in the Revolution. This week we will learn about the battles fought around NC. We will also be discussing the Constitution (preamble) and the Declaration of Independence.



Math—

We are continuing our work last math unit—measurement. This week we will study length, weight, capacity, and time. We are solving conversion word problems and continuing to utilize the C.U.B.E.S strategy. It is a short unit and we will have our test on Friday. We will begin our EOG review next week! Each day we will cover a different topic, practice solving EOG-like questions, and take notes using a prepared review packet.
