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This week in 4th grade:

Carpool Drop-Off and Pick-Up:

Math—Fractions

We are working on finding equivalent fractions through the use of multiplication and division.

Literacy—Poetry, Prose, and Drama

We are beginning our study of poems, drama, and prose! We will continue to switch Tuesdays-Thursdays for Reading Workshop, but then we will return to homerooms where we will have another literacy mini-lesson and rotation activities (guided reading groups, word work, and work on writing). This week, our focus will be on learning about types of figurative language found in poetry.

Social Studies—

We have begun a three week unit on the American Revolution. We will learn some vocabulary related to the revolution and the time period. We will begin the unit learning about the French and Indian War, then progress onto the different acts that led to the American Revolution.

Science—

We will be alternating our science and social studies units. Therefore, we will not have science again until the end of our American Revolution unit!
