This week in 4th grade:

Carpool Drop-Off and Pick-Up:

Math—Fractions

We have begun our unit on fractions. This is a long and fast-paced unit. We are trying to use visuals and be hands-on as much as possible! Last week we worked on decomposing fractions (i.e. 1/2 = 1/4 + 1/4) and this week we are going to use that skill to find equivalent fractions (i.e. 1/2 = 1/4 + 1/4 = 2/4; 1/2=2/4).

Literacy—Text Structure

We are wrapping up our unit on text structure and beginning our study of poems, drama, and prose!



Social Studies—

We are completing our colonial America unit with a final project. Your students are either writing a skit or writing a journal entry from the perspective of their tradesman. We will begin a three week unit on the American Revolution. We will learn some vocabulary related to the revolution and the time period. We will begin the unit learning about the French and Indian War, then progress onto the different acts that led to the American Revolution.

Science—

We will be alternating our science and social studies units. Therefore, we will not have science again until the end of our American Revolution unit!
