

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This week in 4th grade:

Reading—

We are reviewing figurative language terms we have previously learned and learning how to identify the theme of a poem.

Writing—

We are beginning an informational report on one of North Carolina's historical landmarks, places, symbol, or people. Students will be creating a "board" using Discovery Education. This is an online tool where students will be able to incorporate media into their report.

Social Studies—

After the unit on rocks and minerals in Science, we will come back to study the American Revolution including important battles in the country and North Carolina's role in the Revolution.

Science—

We are beginning our new unit in science on rocks and minerals. This week we are learning about weathering, erosion, and deposition.

Math—

We will learn how to multiply a mixed number by a whole number. We will also be reviewing previously learned concepts in the fraction unit in preparation for the unit test on Friday.
