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This week in 4th grade:

Reading—

We are continuing to learn about poetry and figurative language. We will be learning the different elements of poetry and the types of figurative language that often are present in poems. We will also be reading many different types of poems and working on comprehension strategies using those poems.

Writing—

We are working on an opinion writing piece in class. The kids are required to take an opinion on an issue or statement, then support it with evidence. We are working through the writing process with this assignment.

Social Studies—

We will finish up the unit learning about the Boston Massacre, the Intolerable Acts, and the First Continental Congress. We will have an assessment on Thursday. We have been completing a flipbook in class that students are able to use as a study guide.

After the unit on rocks and minerals in science we will come back to study the American Revolution including important battles in the country and North Carolina's role in the Revolution.

Science—
